- Set up, maintenance and successful running of two non-formal adult education centers for the community in different vicinities of Lahore (Pakistan) since 2008.
- Provision of books and stationary to all adult students since 2008.

The need for an affordable housing is staggering. Approximately 40% population either lives in rented, sub-standard house or has no home at all. Families are trapped in a daily struggle to survive often by inhuman living conditions. The SITY Foundation is dedicated to the idea that people deserve a simple, decent and healthy place to live on terms they can afford to pay.

In the first phase of The SITY Shelters program, land is acquired in the outskirts of Lahore. The plots in the SITY Shelters would be allotted to low income and ignored communities on easy installments. Tenants, in particular, are the most deserving incumbents in this regard. "The SITY Foundation" also looks forward to extend the geographical spread of these activities to other areas by establishing more phases of "The SITY Shelters" throughout Pakistan.

### Layyah Clean Water Project

We went to Layyah on 25th of Sep 2011. In the morning of 26th, we went to Sheenwala/Karror for sorting out what are the people who are most deserving and needy. We visited many people and different parts of the village Sheenwala to look at by ourselves that what is the situation and how we could work out with the people. We met many people and took their views about the flood that what was the situation before flood and what is going on in their lives after the flood. The people over there are very open to us and thankful to us that we chose to work in their village.

Mr. Malik Zahoor Sohaag could not go with us due to some medical problem so he gave us a contact person Mr. Bilal in the same village who would coordinate with us and help us to manage the work. Bilal is a local guy from Sheenwala. He knew all the things about that village and he proved to be a very receptive to help us in every matter regarding hand pumps. People in the village know him and respect him. We got to know that people are living in joint families, more like, 3 to 4 families are living together in the same house. So if we give 1 hand pump to a single household that means four families and getting benefits from that hand pump it also means that more than 30 people are benefitting this opportunity including kids.

It was a reasonably nice attempt to support under privileged and 2010 flood effected resident of karror by providing them clean water facility through hand pump.

"TSF Team" has built 25 hand pumps within 25 households on average of 75 families. There exist a lot more need, we were only be able to met the part of the need of the one village instead there are couple mores villages are also deserve the kind of help these people got.

## Projects Sialkot Disaster Area

We left for Sialkot from the office at about 1pm on 13 th June, 2011 and reached “ Rangji ” at 4:30 pm. There we met Mr. Muhammad Nawaz with many other fellows. After having cold drinks as tradition, we moved on to “ Daira Nazir Da ” which is almost 5km away from Rangji towards north of Sialkot. After reaching there we visited some families and individuals who were worn out but one great thing we felt in them that they were not complaining to anyone that no one came to help them.

On Saturday morning 18/06 we got to the market for buying the supplies for the distribution. That took almost whole day for us to buy the things and loading that on a Mazda truck. At the end we loaded the truck with the help of some people there and left around 6:00pm.

Next day we reached Rangji at 3:00am. Our host Nazir was waiting for us so he received us and brought us to the place where he had already prepared for us. We started unloading the truck for packaging. At 7:30am with the help of some local friends we started to put the things in a package.

We called all the beneficiaries from “ Daira Bhattian ” and “ Bahadarpur ” at “ Daira Nazir ” for the distribution. There was another hindrance on the way that road was not so well. During that struggle God arranged a trolley Tractor which was a great help for us to transport all those things there.

The distribution process went all the way up till 10:30pm. We compensated 103 families with that distribution. All the families got the distribution package and went home happily. Of course everyone was in a great need but there were a few widows there who were taken care of firstly. They went back home carrying their stuff with smiling faces.
